Co+opportunity Community Grant Policies

We are committed to making our community better and healthier. To make sure that our “Give Where You Live” cash donations are targeted to help our community as much as possible, we’ve established a few guidelines.

This sheet outlines our process for evaluating donation requests. It will also tell you if your organization is eligible to apply for the grant.

Eligibility

- Your organization must have non-profit status and include a non-profit or tax-exempt documentation with this application.
- Your organization cannot advocate, support or practice unlawful discrimination based on race, religion, national origin, sex, disability or sexual orientation.
- Your organization cannot be a political or religious organization.
- Your organization’s mission should match Co+opportunity’s goals: to help make our community better and healthier and can be described by one of the following issue categories.
 1. *Environmental / Sustainable to the earth*
 2. *Education / The arts*
 3. *Peace & freedom of expression*
 4. *Economic & social justice*
 5. *Civil rights*
- Your organization is located near Co+opportunity
- Your organization has not received the grant in the last three years from Co+opportunity.
- A representative of your organization will be available to attend our annual meeting on October 13, 2019 to accept the grant in person. (Winner will be notified in advance).

Applications must be submitted by October 5, 2019.
